McKinney Fire Department is breaking ground on Station 10

Fire Station 10 will serve the Trinity Falls community

McKINNEY, Texas (Jan. 14, 2019) – The McKinney Fire Department invites the public to the groundbreaking ceremony for Fire Station 10. The station will serve the fast-growing Trinity Falls community and is part of the strategic plan to efficiently protect all areas of the city.

The 16,000-square-foot facility will sit on three acres, include three apparatus bays and will accommodate up to 10 firefighters. There will also be a community room for use by the public. McKinney Fire Station 10 will be completed in spring 2020.
